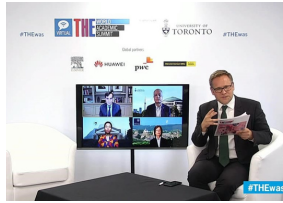

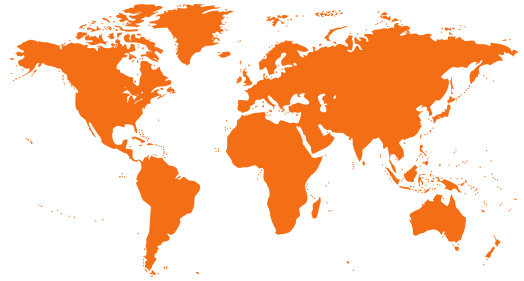

● THEWUR 2024

We are extremely happy to let you all know that our University ranks, for the fifth consecutive time, on the first place in Romania, according to the THEWUR, 2024 edition. At the same time, Bucharest University of Economic Studies ranks 801-1000 worldwide and together with "Carol Davila" University of Medicine and Pharmacy are the only Romanian higher education institutions in the top 1000 of this highly prestigious global university rankings. The THEWUR 2024 includes 1,904 universities across 108 countries and regions. The table is based on a new evaluation methodology, which includes 18 carefully calibrated performance indicators that measure an institution's performance across five areas: teaching, research environment, research quality, industry, and international outlook. This year's ranking analysed more than 134 million citations across 16.5 million research publications and included survey responses from 68,402 scholars globally.

We acknowledge the intense effort our entire community did to achieve this impressive result and thus we would like to congratulate every member of our academic community!

● Erasmus+ incoming students at ASE welcome event and city tour

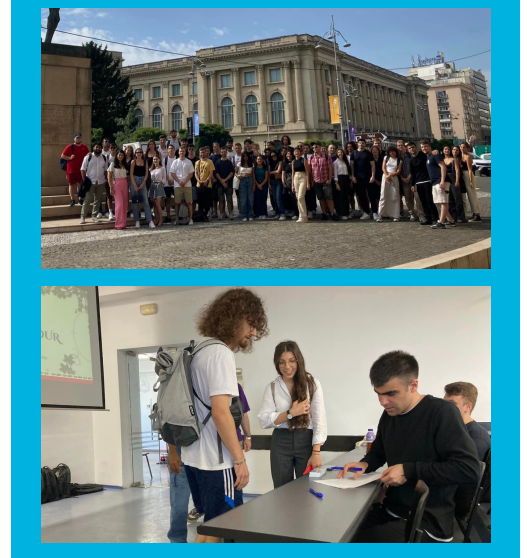
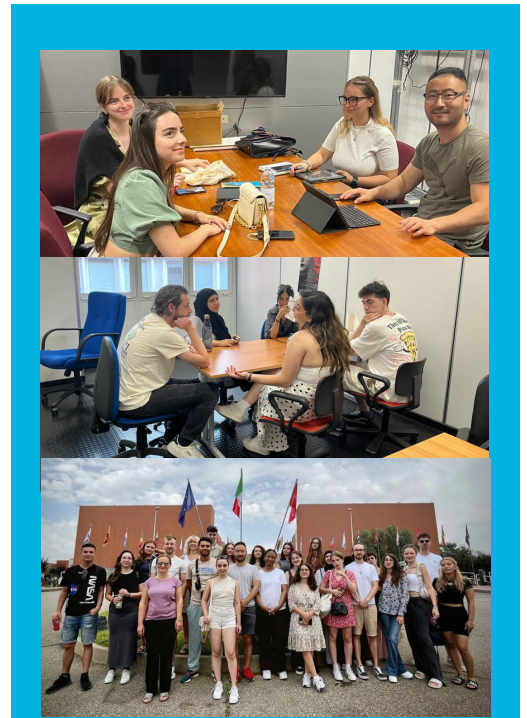
- 22th of September
