9 February 2024

- **Meeting with Nagasaki University delegation**

We had the pleasure to welcome to our University Prof. Masazumi Maruyama and Ms. Setsuko Suenaga from the Faculty of Economics at Nagasaki University. The Japanese delegation is our guests for the next days. During the meeting with Prof. Constantin Marius Profiroiu, Vice-rector for international relations, various opportunities for future cooperation were discussed, from students and staff exchange programs in the framework of Erasmus+ to joint research and comparative studies. - **MIKTA seminar, Bucharest**

The MIKTA seminar, which was organized by ASE Bucharest in collaboration with the Faculty of International Business and Economics and the diplomatic representatives of Indonesia, Mexico, South Korea, and the Republic of Türkiye, was launched today by Prof. Constantin Marius Profiroiu, Vice-rector for International Relations. In his inaugural address, Prof. Profiroiu welcomed the presence in our university's Aula Magna of their Excellencies the ambassadors of the MIKTA countries mentioned earlier as well as of the representative of the Romanian Ministry of Foreign Affairs and emphasized ASE Bucharest's international openness as well as our academic community's contribution to the strengthening of the process of internationalization in higher education, as evidenced by international rankings. MIKTA is an informal consultation and coordination platform among Mexico, Indonesia, Republic of Korea, Türkiye and Australia. MIKTA was initiated by the Foreign Ministers of the MIKTA member countries on 25 September 2013 on the margins of the 68th UN General Assembly. MIKTA members are democracies that benefit from open economies with robust growth rates and a significant level of economic power. They are strategically located and strongly linked to their surrounding regions. MIKTA members are also like-minded on many of the global challenges of our time and are active contributors in international fora.



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MIKTA aims to contribute constructive solutions to regional and global challenges as well as enhancing effectiveness of global governance. Therefore, MIKTA aims at strengthening its cooperation in order to raise its voice on global issues and gain influence within the international organisations. MIKTA countries also work to strengthen their economic and political ties.

28 February - 1 March 2024

- **UNICA Days, Brussels**

During 28 February - 1 March 2024 in Brussels, the Network of Universities from the Capitals of Europe organises UNICA Days, an international event meant to gather representatives from all member universities, UNICA working groups, high officials from ministries of education from Europe and EU institutions.

On this occasion, our colleagues from the International Relations Department attended the interactive sessions and debates on the democratic mission of universities in the light of the current European context and the EU Parliament elections, the developments in transnational cooperation on education in Europe with a special focus on the European Alliances, visions for a new European research and innovation strategy in the era of digitalization and artificial intelligence.

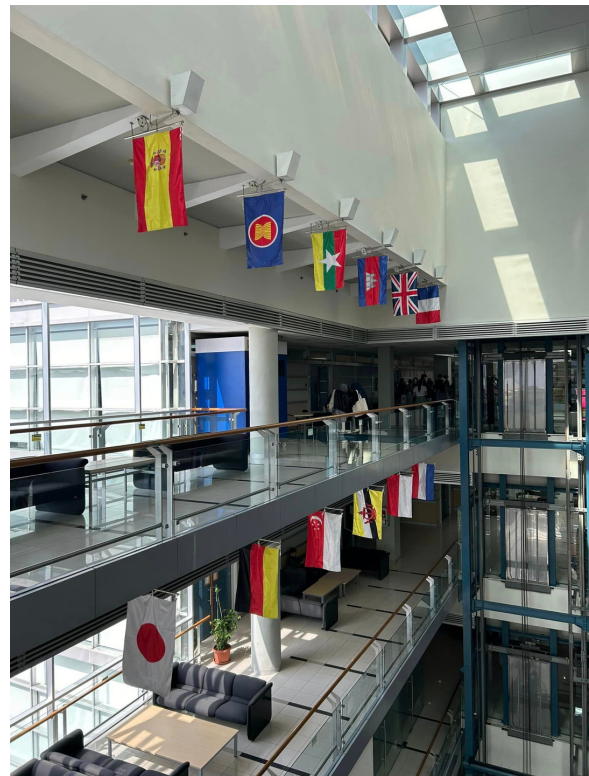

AIESEC is one of the largest international youth organizations with members from over 120 countries focusing on leadership development through practical and cross-cultural experiences. We want to invest in the potential of young people in Romania and impact as many people and communities as possible, and in this sense, we offer young people between the ages of 18 and 28 the opportunity to go on exchange experiences such as international volunteering. They have the opportunity to encounter new cultures and develop both hard and soft skills, while making an impact in the local community.

The Global Volunteer program offers young people the unique experience of volunteering in a new environment. The projects are based on one of the 17 UN Sustainable Development Goals, so they offer a variety of causes that young people can directly contribute to through their efforts, such as quality education, gender equality, responsible consumption and production, and more. For 6 weeks, volunteers will have the opportunity to explore a new country, interact with new cultures and support important causes, all of which also contribute to their personal development.

During the experience, the participants will have their accommodation provided by the local AIESEC, and they will have the full support of AIESEC in Bucharest through all the stages of the process.

Also, for ASE students, there is also the opportunity to benefit from an Erasmus scholarship. The only condition is that they extend their stay in the host by 2 more weeks. The cost for signing up to any of the projects is 190 euros, which ensures all the benefits mentioned above.
