

Internationalization at home

3rd of October

- Transylvanian International Conference in Public Administration organized by the Department of Public Administration and Management at Babes-Bolyai University in Cluj-Napoca

Prof. Constantin Marius Profiroiu, the vice-rector for international relations, is participating as a guest speaker at the 6th edition of the Transylvanian International Conference in Public Administration organized by the Department of Public Administration and Management at Babes-Bolyai University in Cluj-Napoca. The conference is designed as an event envisioned to bring together academics, researchers, and practitioners in the field of public administration from all over the world and to create a framework in which they can exchange ideas, disseminate best practices, and develop networking opportunities for future teaching, research, and capacity building projects.

The overarching topic for 2024 is fostering local and regional innovation through partnerships, with an emphasis on the role of universities. The conference is focused on critically discussing and analyzing characteristics and dynamics of local innovation systems, on defining local and locality about existing cities and communities, and more importantly on assessing how universities enter into and interact with the other actors in the local networks whose interactions initialize, stimulate and diffuse economically useful knowledge. Regional innovation systems and the role of universities within them can be examined from various perspectives, including power relations and negotiation, communication and marketing, strategic planning, leadership studies, etc. The conference welcomes all these perspectives as we strive to explore this topic through contributions from different academic fields.


27th of October


31st of October
